1. Methodological information

1.1. Introduction

This standard table on access to treatment is aimed at collecting quantitative data on the number of people reached by drug treatment across the national treatment system in the Member States, and more specifically the number of clients receiving substitution/maintenance treatment. It complements data on the characteristics of people accessing drug treatment in Europe, collected through monitoring systems, based on the EMCDDA Treatment Demand Indicator. Furthermore, the present standard table aims to map information on treatment services for specific target groups in the Member States.

1.3. Definitions

Drug Treatment : same as in the TDI protocol

Specialised Drug Treatment Centres : Specialised drug treatment centres comprise public or private, governmental or non-governmental facilities which specialise in and whose primary focus is the treatment of drug dependence on an outpatient basis. Note that primary focus indicates the services the facility primarily provides.

Low-threshold Agencies (LTA) :The term 'low-threshold' describes an implementation setting that facilitates drug users' access to health and social services, in particular those that help to prevent and reduce health-related harm associated with drug use. To encourage drug users to enter into contact, the use of these services typically requires little bureaucracy, often no payment, and is not conditional upon being or becoming drug-free. They target current users, 'hard-to-reach' and high-risk groups among drug users and experimental users.

General Health / Mental Health Care Centres (GHCC) : General health care and mental health centres comprise public or private, governmental or non-governmental outpatient facilities which provide outpatient drug treatment services to drug users among a range of other health and mental health services. The primary focus of these facilities is not drug treatment provision.

This category includes General Practitioners (medical doctors in private practice.)

Note distinction vis-à-vis specialist outpatient drug treatment centres.

General/mental health care centres provide health services to a wider target group that includes drug users. What we want to know is how many drug users received services related to their drug treatment in these units

Treatment Units in Prisons (PRI) : Treatment Units in prison are facilities (dedicated physical spaces) inside prisons where qualified socio-medical staff (external or internal to the prison, but employed or delegated by the prison health administration) deliver treatment services to prison inmates.

Hospital-based Residential Drug Treatment Units : Specialist medical, psychiatric and/or psychosocial treatment services that address drug dependency, carried out in hospitals (often psychiatric hospitals or psychiatric wards in general hospitals).

Residential Drug Treatment Centres (non-hospital setting) : Treatment environments in which drug-dependent individuals live together and follow a programme of counselling or therapy in order to achieve social and psychological change. A range of theoretical approaches, including family, psychodynamic, cognitive-behavioural therapy, medical or 12-step approaches may underpin residential treatment programmes.

Therapeutic Communities : Typically a drug-free environment in which drug-dependent individuals live together in an organised and structured way in order to promote social and psychological change. The central philosophy is that residents are active participants in their own and each other's treatment and that responsibility for the daily running of the community is shared among residents and staff members.

Drug substitution treatment / maintenance therapy : Treatment of drug dependence by prescription of a substitute drug (agonists and antagonists) for which cross-dependence and cross-tolerance exists, with the goal to reduce or eliminate the use of a particular substance, especially if it is illegal, or to reduce harm from a particular method of administration, the attendant dangers for health (e.g. from needle sharing), and the social consequences. (Demand Reduction – A Glossary of terms, UNDCP, no year). Substitute drugs used in substitution/maintenance therapy are prescribed in relatively stable doses over a long period of time (usually more than three months), which allows stabilization of brain functions and prevention of craving and withdrawal.
