

Changes in case definition

In 2013 the data collection system PREDA was updated in line with new treatment definitions and scope according to the Treatment Demand Indicator (TDI) v.3.:

- <u>before</u> outpatient tretment centres, <u>after</u> outpatient + inpatient centres;
- a lot of work and comunication with treatment centres and doctors during and after changes – informed about all changes in definitions and Registry structure.



Coding error

The main drug – patient himself or reported from other person




Other opioids (especially some new synthetic opioid instead heroin)






Drug seizure data 2007-2016








Heroin/new synthetic opioids seizures, 2009-2017 (I half of the year)
